

Please bring 2-3 Needed Items for Homeless Students in Balt County Schools

Hard to believe... There are 91 schools in Baltimore County with 50% students in severe poverty; 21 schools with 40-49%; 18 schools with 30%; 14 schools with 25%; 13 schools with 10-19% and 13 schools with less than 10% students in severe poverty. Approx 2,700 are homeless!

Laurie Taylor Mitchell has come up with a way to help these schools help their students.

The organization she started is called Student Support Network. Since she started this, many Baltimore County schools have joined. Originally it was Loch Raven Network.

The main problem is **FOOD INSECURITY** meaning the limited or uncertain access to healthy food. In Dec, 2017, 2,020 students were identified as homeless in BCoPS, an increase of over 200 from the previous year.

These students are at high risk of hunger, bullying, depression and attempted suicide.
